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LAW OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

ABOUT PLANT PROTECTION

Passed by the Legislative Chamber on 6, 2023

Approved by the Senate on 10, 2023

Chapter 1. General Provisions

Article 1. Purpose of this Law

The purpose of this Law is to regulate relations in the field of plant protection.

Article 2. Legislation on plant protection

The legislation on plant protection consists of this Law and other legislative acts.

If an international treaty of the Republic of Uzbekistan establishes rules that differ from those provided for by the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan on plant protection, then the rules of the international treaty shall apply.

Article 3. Basic concepts

The following basic concepts are used in this Law:

biological protection agents - beneficial organisms or products of their activity used to combat harmful organisms of plants and plant products;

harmful organisms - any species, race or biotype of plants, animal and human pests and agents capable of causing harm to plants or plant products;

chemicalization agents - chemical agents used to accelerate the growth and maturation, increase the yield and quality of plants, as well as improve soil fertility;

mineral fertilizers - manufactured or mined fertilizers containing nutrients in mineral form;

pesticides - substances used to control harmful organisms;

phytosanitary measures - a set of measures aimed at reducing economic damage caused by harmful organisms;

plant protection is a set of measures aimed at combating harmful organisms;

Plant protection products - chemical products used to protect plants and plant products.

Article 4. Basic principles in the field of plant protection

The main principles in the field of plant protection are:

legality;

priority of human health and environmental safety;

systematicity and continuity;

priority of application of biological method;

openness and transparency.

Chapter 2. State administration in the field of plant protection

Article 5. Powers of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the field of plant protection

Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan:

ensures the implementation of a unified state policy in the field of plant protection;

approves and organizes the implementation of state programs in the field of plant protection;

approves the procedure for conducting tests for the registration, import and production of chemicals and plant protection products, issuing permits for the production of mineral fertilizers and chemicals used for plant protection, licensing of the wholesale and retail trade of mineral fertilizers and chemicals used for plant protection;

determines the procedure for implementing state control in the field of plant protection;

approves general technical regulations in the field of plant protection;

approves the procedure for the import and export of biological protection products;

approves the List of harmful organisms of non-quarantine significance on the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan may also exercise the powers in accordance with the legislation.

Article 6. Powers of the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the field of plant protection

Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Uzbekistan:

implements a unified state policy in the field of plant protection;

participates in the development and implementation of state and other programs in the field of plant protection;

carries out research, development and design work on the creation and implementation of chemicals and plant protection products, new and advanced technological processes and methods of their application in agriculture;

provides training, retraining and advanced training for specialists in the field of plant protection;

participates in the development and implementation of state and other programs and recommendations for the use of chemicals and plant protection products;

determines the need of agriculture for chemical and biological means of plant protection, the formation of reserves of chemical agents in case of emergency situations.

The Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Uzbekistan may also exercise the powers in accordance with the legislation.

Article 7. Powers of the Agency for Quarantine and Plant Protection under the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the field of plant protection

The Agency for Quarantine and Plant Protection under the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Uzbekistan is a specially authorized state body in the field of plant protection (hereinafter referred to as the specially authorized state body).

Specially authorized state body:

participates in the development and implementation of state and other programs in the field of plant protection;

develops and implements an integrated pest control system;

takes measures to prevent the risk of introducing harmful organisms from other countries into the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan and to combat the consequences of their introduction;

develops technical regulations on chemicals and plant protection products.

permits the import of chemicals and plant protection products, registration, and scientific research;

coordinates activities related to the import and export of biological agents;

carries out registration of chemicals and plant protection products, certificate of registration of chemicals and plant protection products;

issues a license for the implementation of activities in the wholesale of mineral fertilizers and chemicals used for plant protection;

issues permits for the import of mineral fertilizers and chemicals for plant protection;

maintains and publishes the List of chemical and biological pests, plant diseases and weeds, defoliants and plant growth regulators applied together with the Committee for Sanitary and Epidemiological Welfare and Public Health under the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan and Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan;

identifies active and inactive ingredients of plant protection products that are or restricted in use, maintains and monitors the Register of active and inactive ingredients of plant protection products that are prohibited or restricted in use;

coordinates the activities of the republican executive authorities in the production and use of chemicals and plant protection products, compliance with regulations, and determining the impact of plant protection products on human health and the environment;

controls the quality of chemicals and plant protection products, issues permits for their use, and prohibits their use if harmful effects on human health and the environment are detected;

organizes training, retraining and advanced training of personnel in the field of plant protection;

develops and approves guidelines and recommendations for the use of chemicals and plant protection products;

develops and submits for approval to the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan a List of harmful organisms of non-quarantine significance on the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan;

carries out state control over the implementation of legislation on plant protection;

carries out international cooperation in the field of plant protection;

implements an automated information system for the accounting, sale, use, disposal, burial and destruction of chemicals and plant protection products;

A specially authorized state body may also exercise other powers in accordance with the law.

Article 8. Powers of the Committee for Sanitary and Epidemiological Welfare and Public Health under the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the field of plant protection

Committee for Sanitary and Epidemiological Welfare and Public Health under the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan:

carries out state sanitary supervision over compliance with national and international regulations during the production, storage, sale, use, transportation, circulation, rendering harmless, utilization, burial and destruction of chemicals and plant protection products;

organizes and conducts scientific research on toxicological and hygienic aspects of the use of chemicals and plant protection products, develops hygienic standards and technical regulations for pesticides in the field of plant protection;

production facilities and environmental objects;

conducts state toxicological examination of residual amounts of pesticides in agricultural and other plant products;

conducts state sanitary and hygienic examination of plant protection products;

organizes preliminary and periodic medical examinations of persons using plant protection products, as well as diagnostics of patients with pesticide poisoning;

The Committee for Sanitary and Epidemiological Welfare and Public Health under the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan may also exercise other powers in accordance with the legislation.

Article 9. Powers of the Ministry of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the field of plant protection

The Ministry of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan:

carries out an assessment of the environmental impact of plant protection products submitted for registration;

conducts state environmental assessments of chemicals and plant protection products;

participates in the process of burying unusable chemicals and plant protection products and containers from them;

carries out state control over compliance with environmental requirements during the production, transportation, storage, use, disposal, and destruction of chemicals and plant protection products;

regulates the activities of special facilities for the storage or disposal of unusable chemicals and other toxic substances in the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The Ministry of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan may also exercise other powers in accordance with the legislation.

Article 10. Powers of local government bodies in the field of plant protection

Local government bodies:

participate in the development and implementation of state and territorial programs in the field of plant protection;

approve and implement territorial programs in the field of plant protection;

in agreement with the Ministry of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan, a specially authorized state body, the Committee for Sanitary and Epidemiological Welfare and Public Health under the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan organize work on the disinfection of chemicals and plant protection products that have become unusable and (or) are prohibited for use;

coordinate the activities of territorial divisions of republican executive bodies and economic management bodies in carrying out phytosanitary measures and combating harmful organisms;

form a reserve of chemicals used to protect plants;

approve programs to combat harmful organisms, including harmful insects and diseases;

form working groups to prevent emergency situations that may arise in the field of plant protection and coordinate their activities.

Local government bodies may also exercise other powers in accordance with the legislation.

Chapter 3. State control in the field of plant protection

Article 11. Implementation of state control in the field of plant protection

State control over the implementation of legislation on plant republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities is carried out by a specially authorized state body.

A specially authorized state body exercises state control over:

implementation of measures to protect plants from harmful organisms;

compliance with the procedure for obtaining a permit for the import of fertilizers and chemicals used for plant protection, a license for carrying out wholesale and retail trade of mineral fertilizers and chemicals used for plant protection;

compliance with the procedure for inspection of the import of mineral fertilizers and chemicals used to protect plants, their storage, sale, use, transportation, and circulation, rendering harmless, disposal, burial and destruction;

compliance with the procedure for import and export of biological products;

compliance with technological processes for the production of biological products and requirements for the quality indicators of biological products

Verification of compliance with sanitary and environmental requirements for production, storage, sale, use, transportation, withdrawal from circulation, rendering harmless, utilization, burial and destruction of chemicals and plant protection products carried out within the framework of state sanitary supervision and environmental protection.

The procedure for implementing state control in the field of plant protection is determined by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Article 12. Rights of state plant quarantine inspectors in the protection

State plant quarantine inspectors, within the limits of their authority to:

enter the territory of republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals in the manner established by law;

in the event of detection of violations of plant protection legislation, prohibit the import of goods containing chemicals and plant protection products into the Republic of Uzbekistan;

request information from customs authorities, administrations of bus stations, airports and other organizations about imported and exported plant protection products;

require documents in accordance with the procedure for import of biological protection products;

issue mandatory instructions to eliminate and prevent violations of plant protection legislation;

to select samples of chemicals and plant protection products for laboratory and relevant examination in order to determine their compliance with the requirements for registration of chemicals and plant protection products;

carry out phytosanitary monitoring and forecasting, as well as state implementation of plant protection measures in order to prevent the spread of harmful organisms.

State plant quarantine inspectors may also have other rights in accordance with the law.

Article 13. Duties of state plant quarantine inspectors in the protection

State plant quarantine inspectors are required to:

when importing mineral fertilizers and chemicals used for plant protection, check the presence of a permit for the import of mineral fertilizers and chemicals for plant protection and assess their compliance with this permit;

when importing and exporting biological protection products, conduct an assessment of their compliance with the phytosanitary certificate and quality requirements;

organize laboratory tests of chemicals and plant protection products;

if necessary, request and evaluate documents related to the production and quality of plant protection products;

monitor the effectiveness of biological control agents;

determine measures to protect plants from harmful organisms.

State plant quarantine inspectors may also have other duties in accordance with the law.

Chapter 4. Rights and obligations of republican executive bodies, management bodies, legal entities and individuals in the field of plant protection

Article 14. Rights of republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals in the field of plant protection

Republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals have the right to:

require a specially authorized state body to conduct phytosanitary control surveys in order to identify harmful organisms;

submit applications for registration of chemicals and plant protection products, conclude agreements with organizations conducting tests for registration of chemicals and plant protection products;

participate in the development of measures to combat harmful organisms;

appeal decisions to refuse to consider an application for registration of chemicals and plant protection products, to issue or refuse to issue a certificate of registration of chemicals and plant protection products in accordance with the procedure established by law;

receive information and data relating to plant protection from relevant agencies;

import into the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan and export of chemicals and plant protection products in the manner established by law.

Republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals may also have other rights in accordance with the law.

Article 15. Responsibilities of republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals in the field of plant protection

Republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals are obliged to:

comply with the rules for the use of chemicals and plant protection products;

provide the required number of samples and technical documentation for registration of chemicals and plant protection products, standards for comparison and analytical substances for the purpose of conducting tests for registration of chemicals and plant protection products;

comply with the safety requirements specified in technical regulations for the use of chemicals and plant protection products;

neutralize chemicals and plant protection products and store them in special storage facilities or special rooms;

comply with mandatory instructions from state plant quarantine inspectors.

use certified biological protection products;
implement phytosanitary measures in a timely manner;
comply with the procedure and rules established by law for the transportation, sale and use of chemicals and plant protection products, and contamination of plants, agricultural and other plant products and the use of these products.

Republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals may bear other responsibilities in accordance with the law.

Chapter 5. Registration of chemicals and plant protection products and for safe handling

Article 16. Registration of chemicals and plant protection products

Chemicals and plant protection products produced in the Republic of Uzbekistan or imported from other countries are subject to registration.

Registration of chemicals and plant protection products is carried out by an authorized government agency based on the results of tests conducted.

Chemicals and plant protection products are registered for a period of five years.

The production, import, sale and use of chemicals and plant protection products that have not undergone registration shall be prohibited, with the exception of plant protection products provided for in [Article 22](#) of this Law.

A fee is charged for registration of chemicals and plant protection products in an amount established by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Article 17. Conducting tests for registration of chemicals and plant protection products

Conducting tests for registration of chemicals and plant protection products includes:

determination of the effectiveness of the use of chemicals and plant protection products;

assessment of the danger of the negative impact of chemicals and plant protection products on human health and the development of sanitary norms and standards;

environmental assessment of the use of chemicals and plant protection products.

A specially authorized state body conducts a study of the documents submitted by applicants, together with the Committee for Sanitary and Epidemiological Control of Public Health under the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Ministry of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Based on the results of the study, a plan for conducting tests for the registration of chemicals and plant protection products is approved or the testing is refused.

A specially authorized government agency approves the List of chemicals and plant protection products for conducting tests for the registration of chemicals and plant protection products.

Tests for the registration of chemicals and plant protection products are conducted in accordance with plans approved in the manner established in this article, to determine the biological effectiveness, toxicological and hygienic and environmental properties of chemicals and plant protection products.

Republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals who have submitted an application for registration of chemicals and plant protection products are required to provide samples of chemicals and plant protection products in the required quantity, technical documentation, standards and analytical standards of active substances for testing.

The period for conducting tests for registration of chemicals and plant protection products is determined by the authorized government agency.

The period for conducting tests for registration of chemicals and plant protection products should not exceed two years.

Article 18. Conclusion on the results of tests for registration of plant protection products

Organizations that conducted tests for the registration of chemical protection products prepare a corresponding conclusion or scientific report to a specially authorized government agency.

A specially authorized state body prepares a final conclusion, conclusions and scientific reports and, based on their results, makes a registration or refusal to register chemicals and plant protection products.

A specially authorized state body analyzes and evaluates the test results for registration of chemicals and plant protection products.

If a negative conclusion is made based on the results of the tests conducted by organizations that conducted the tests, or by one of them, the registration of chemicals and plant protection products is refused.

The period for preparing a conclusion on the test results for registration of chemicals and plant protection products should not exceed six months.

Persons who have submitted an application for registration of chemical protection products, as well as manufacturers of these products, do not participate in the preparation of a conclusion on the results of tests for chemicals and plant protection products.

The conclusion on the results of tests for registration of chemical protection products may be appealed in accordance with the established procedure.

Article 19. Issuance of a certificate of registration of chemical protection products

The decision of a specially authorized state body on the registration of chemical protection products is the basis for issuing a certificate of registration of chemicals and plant protection products.

The form of the certificate of registration of chemicals and plant protection products is established by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Article 20. Re-registration of chemicals and plant protection products

Re-registration of chemicals and plant protection products is carried out in accordance with the procedure established by law, by a specially authorized state body on the basis of a corresponding application.

Article 21. Termination of the certificate of registration of chemical protection products

The validity of the certificate of registration of chemicals and plant protection products shall be terminated in the following cases:

the composition of the chemicals and plant protection products used differs from the registered composition;

there is new scientifically confirmed data on the possibility of harm to human health, the environment or biological protection products when using chemicals and plant protection products;

Adverse properties and low biological efficiency of registered chemical protection products have been identified.

The validity of the certificate of registration of chemicals and plant protection products shall be terminated by a specially authorized state body on the basis of the conclusion of the Committee for Sanitary and Epidemiological Welfare and Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan, and the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Article 22. Experimental use of unregistered plant protection prod

Experimental use of unregistered plant protection products is permitted for up to one year in the event of circumstances requiring urgent measures on plants.

Permission for the experimental use of plant protection products is granted by a specially authorized state body in agreement with the Ministry of Ecology Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Ministry of Sanitary and Epidemiological Welfare and Public Health under the Ministry of the Republic of Uzbekistan for a period of one growing season for a predetermined territory.

When issuing a permit for the experimental use of plant protection products, the specially authorized state body determines the rules and conditions for its implementation.

Upon expiration of the experimental period of application of plant protection products, the head of the experiment shall submit to the specially authorized state body a report on the results of the experiment, as well as information on the remains of plant protection products, devices and equipment.

Article 23. Standardization, certification and labeling of chemical protection products

Standardization and certification of chemicals and plant protection products are carried out by the Uzbek Agency for Technical Regulation under the Ministry of Investments, Industry and Trade of the Republic of Uzbekistan, with the exception of biological protection products.

Certification of the quality of biological protection products is carried out by a specially authorized government body.

The marking of chemicals and plant protection products is carried out by the manufacturer.

The procedure for standardization, certification and labeling of chemical protection products is determined by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Article 24. Sale, import and export of chemicals and plant protection products

Chemicals and plant protection products are permitted for sale on the territory of the Republic of Uzbekistan, import and export after receiving a certificate of their registration in the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The import of mineral fertilizers and chemicals used for plant protection is carried out on the basis of the relevant permit.

Activities related to wholesale and retail trade in mineral fertilizers used for plant protection are carried out on the basis of a license.

Article 25. Application of chemicals and plant protection products

Chemicals and plant protection products are used taking into account the phytosanitary, sanitary and environmental situation.

Mineral fertilizers are applied taking into account the needs of plants and the soil, as well as the results of the assessment of the state of soil fertility on the basis of soil and other analyses.

The use of chemicals and plant protection products is carried out in accordance with the safety requirements specified in the relevant technical regulations.

Article 26. Information on the safe handling of chemicals and plant protection products

In order to provide consumers with information on the safe handling of chemicals and plant protection products, legal entities and individuals who have

application for registration of chemicals and plant protection products provide them with information on the transportation, use, storage and chemicals and plant protection products and a container label with warnin

When selling chemicals and plant protection products, the seller place recommendations on each unit of container regarding the tran storage and packaging of chemicals and plant protection products, as container label.

The form of recommendations for the transportation, use, storage at chemicals and plant protection products and the requirements for the container labels are determined by a specially authorized government age

Article 27. Requirements for the production of chemicals and p products

Manufacturers of chemicals and plant protection products are require production of chemicals and plant protection products in a regulatory documentation in packaging that is convenient and safe for the retail trade;

compliance of residual amounts of chemicals and plant protection p and medicinal raw materials and food products with established standards

termination of the sale of chemicals and plant protection proc withdrawal from circulation in accordance with the established procedure non-compliance with safety requirements during sale, use, transportati their effectiveness has decreased.

Materials used for containers and packaging of chemicals and p products must be specially adapted to protect humans and the environ hazardous properties of chemicals and plant protection products, r destructive or other effects of their constituent substances, and not intera them in a manner that causes hazardous consequences.

The production of unregistered chemicals and plant protectio prohibited.

Article 28. Storage of chemicals and plant protection products

Storage of chemicals and plant protection products is permitted storage facilities or special rooms. Storage of chemicals and plant prot without special containers is prohibited.

When storing chemicals and plant protection products, sanitary norm environmental standards must be observed.

Requirements for the storage of chemicals and plant protectio defined in general technical regulations approved by the Cabinet of I Republic of Uzbekistan.

Article 29. Requirements for the neutralization, disposal, burial a of chemicals and plant protection products that have become unusal prohibited for use and containers from under them

The neutralization, disposal, burial and destruction of chemicals and products that have become unusable and (or) are prohibited for use, and under them are carried out in the manner established by the Cabinet of Republic of Uzbekistan.

The neutralization, utilization, burial and destruction of chemi protection products that have become unusable and (or) prohibited for use from them are carried out by legal entities and individuals under the representatives of a specially authorized state body, the Ministry of Ecology Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan, the Commi and Epidemiological Welfare and Public Health under the Ministry o

and Epidemiological Welfare and Public Health under the Ministry of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Legal entities and individuals are required to comply with sanitary standards when storing, using, rendering harmless and burying chemical protection products and containers from them, as well as requirements for flora and fauna.

Article 30. Requirements for the transportation of chemical protection products

The transportation of chemicals and plant protection products is carried out in specially equipped vehicles, excluding the possibility of causing harm to people and the environment.

The procedure for the transportation of chemicals and plant protection products is approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Article 31. Environmentally potentially hazardous situations

In the event of the occurrence of ecologically potentially hazardous situations during the production, storage, transportation and use of highly toxic, highly flammable, radioactive and other substances used to protect plants, a special regime is established around the relevant production facilities and along transportation routes in accordance with the law.

Chapter 6. Final Provisions

Article 32. International cooperation in the field of plant protection

International cooperation in the field of plant protection is carried out in accordance with international treaties and the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Within the framework of international cooperation in the field of plant protection, a specially authorized state body:

carries out mutual exchange of information with competent authorities in neighboring countries and international organizations implementing state control in the field of plant protection;

monitors compliance with mandatory requirements for the use of agricultural lands, places of cultivation and packaging of plant products intended for import and export of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

Article 33. Financing of plant protection activities

Every year, funds are allocated from the State Budget of the Republic of Uzbekistan to combat harmful organisms and ensure phytosanitary safety.

Plant protection activities are financed from the State Budget of the Republic of Uzbekistan, extra-budgetary funds and other sources not prohibited by law.

Expenses related to public services of a specially authorized state body in the field of plant protection, as well as the preparation of necessary documents, are covered from the relevant republican executive bodies, economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals.

Republican executive authorities and economic management bodies, legal entities and individuals bear the costs of ensuring plant protection in the territories under their jurisdiction at their own expense.

Article 34. Dispute resolution

Disputes in the field of plant protection are resolved in accordance with the procedure established by law.

Article 35. Liability for violation of plant protection legislation

Persons guilty of violating plant protection legislation are held liable in accordance with the established procedure.

Article 36. Recognition of some legislative acts of the Republic of Uzbekistan

6) **Article 3** of the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated April 26, 2021 "On Amendments to Certain Legislative Acts of the Republic of Uzbekistan with the Improvement of the Sanitary and Epidemiological Service" (Bulletin of the Chambers of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan, 2021, No. 4, Art. 2).

Article 37. Ensuring the implementation, communication, and explanation of the essence and meaning of this Law

The Agency for Quarantine and Plant Protection under the Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Uzbekistan and other interested organizations shall ensure the implementation, dissemination to the performers and explanation to the public of the essence and significance of this Law.

Article 38. Bringing legislation into line with this Law

To the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan:

bring government decisions into compliance with this Law;

ensure the revision and repeal by the republican executive and regulatory legal acts that contradict this Law.

Article 39. Entry into force of this Law

This Law shall enter into force three months after the date of its official publication.
